

U.S. Navy Hospital Corpsman

Lloyd Lavern Heath was one of six children born to Doyle and Francis Heath in Vincennes Indiana. He was born on January 14, 1946.

They moved to Bicknell Indiana where he attended North Knox High School and graduated in the Class of 1965. He enlisted in the United States Navy on July 7, 1965. He was rated and trained as a Hospital Corpsman.

He was deployed to Viet Nam in 1966 and on May 2, 1967 he was killed in action. He was **21** years old at the time of his death.

He was married to Barbara (Nee Patterson) of Grayslake Illinois. They had one daughter (Amber Lee) who was born after he had deployed to Viet Nam. Sadly, they were never to meet.

In honor of his service and sacrifice to his country the Streamwood VFW Post 5151 is graciously named the "Arnold-Heath Memorial Post" sharing his name with the name of another fallen Viet Nam Veteran.

ROBIN LEE ARNOLD

<u>U.S. Marine Corps. Lance Corporal</u> <u>D.O.B. 02/12/1948</u> <u>D.O.D. 07/24/1966</u>

Robin Lee ("Tink") Arnold was one of six children born to Andrew and Corinne Arnold. He was born on February 12, 1948. At the time of his birth they resided in Wisconsin.

In 1959 he and his family moved to Streamwood Illinois where he attended the Larkin High School in Elgin Illinois but left school before graduating to enlist in the United States Marine Corps.

Achieving the rank of Lance Corporal he was deployed to Viet Nam and arrived in June of 1966. His stay was to be a short one as on July 24, 1966 during Operation Hastings at Hill 362 he was killed in action. He was **18** years old at his time of death.

Robin was never married.

In honor of his service and sacrifice to his country the Streamwood VFW POST 5151 is graciously named the "Arnold-Heath Memorial Post" sharing his name with the name of another fallen Viet Nam Veteran.
